Comments: Fresh 'N Clean can also be used as a laundry pre-wash spotter for grease, tar, and many other stains.

Directions: **Traffic Lane Pre-Spray:** For heavy soil, tar, asphalt and tough grease, use product undiluted. For lighter soils, mix 1 quart of product with 2 quarts of water. Use a tank sprayer set to fan spray and lightly spray the surface to be cleaned. Allow pre-spray to set 5-10 minutes before shampooing or extracting. **Bonnet Cleaning:** Mix 1 quart of product with 1 gallon of water. Using a tank sprayer set to fan spray, wet surface of carpet. Work area with carpet bonnet, turning the bonnet as it becomes dirty. Overlap and work carpet evenly to prevent streaking. If mixture sets for more than 1 hour, shake before using. Rinse bonnets clean after using.

Product Disposal: Dispose of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. It is recommended that the high density polyethylene container and any corrugated packaging be recycled.
