Description: Laurel-D is a blend of detergents, foam boosters, soil suspending agents and brighteners formulated for the safe and effective shampooing of all types of carpeting. Can be used with either the rotary, bonnet or dry foam method. Contains no solvents, acids or alkalis to affect colors, cause browning or damage fabrics. Laurel-D is effective in hard or soft, cold or warm water, and is non-corrosive.

Comments: As with all carpet shampoos, do not over wet surface or get liquid on natural wood surfaces. Avoid setting wood or metal furniture directly on wet carpet. Vacuum all residue from carpet after it is completely dry.

Directions: **Carpet** - Dry vacuum the carpet before beginning. Mix solution of 8 oz. of shampoo to each gallon of warm water and pour into carpet shampoo tank. Release solution onto the carpet as you shampoo, building up an even, but not too heavy, coat of foam. Extract dirt and excess water. Let carpet dry completely, then dry vacuum to pick up residue. **Upholstery** - Make a solution of 4 to 8 oz. of Laurel D per gallon of water, depending on soil conditions. Apply sparingly to surface and agitate with soft brush. Wipe away excess foam with a damp sponge or cloth and clean water. Do not overwet.

Product Disposal: This product is non-hazardous material. Dispose of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. It is recommended that the high density polyethylene container and any corrugated packaging be recycled.
